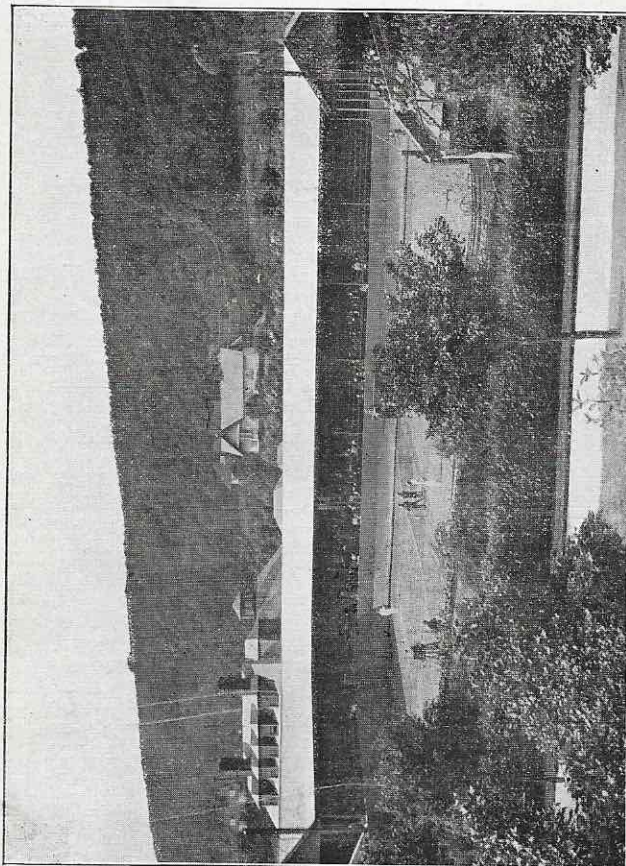

RULES OF THE YORKSHIRE LAWN TENNIS ASSOCIATION

□ □ □

Name.

1.—The Association shall be called "The Yorkshire Lawn Tennis Association."

Objects.

- 2.—The objects of the Association shall be :—
- (a) To uphold the Laws of the Game.
 - (b) To arrange and manage the County Championship and other representative matches and contests.
 - (c) To arrange Competitions and make all rules and regulations for the conduct and management thereof.
 - (d) To regulate, organise, and control the game in the County, and generally to advance the interests thereof.

Constitution.

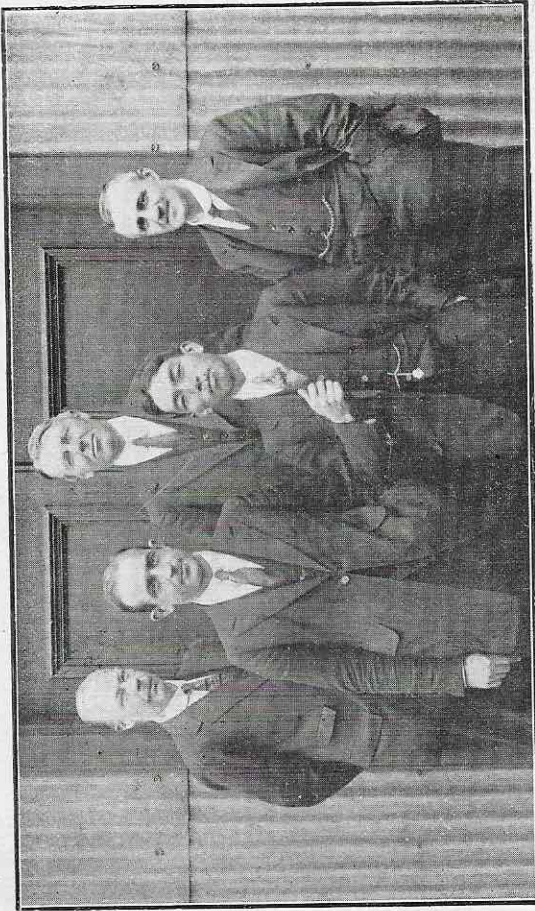
3.—The Association shall consist of Affiliated Clubs and individual Members.

Management.

4.—The Association shall be managed by a Council consisting of a President, Vice-President, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Secretary, and as many Councillors as there are Districts under Rule 13. Three members shall form a quorum.

Applications for Affiliation.

5.—All applications for affiliation must be made in writing to the Honorary Secretary of the Association, and in case of Clubs must be signed by the Club Honorary Secretary. The acceptance or rejection of such applications shall rest entirely with the Council.

Subscriptions.

6.—The first annual subscription to the Association shall be payable on receipt of notice of application, and thereafter the annual subscription shall be due and payable on the first day of March in each year. The amount of such subscription shall be in accordance with the following scale :—

(a) For Clubs comprising not less than 500 Full Playing Members ..	£6	6	0
Not less than 300 Full Playing Members but less than 500 ..	5	5	0
(b) Not less than 200 but less than 300 Full Playing Members ..	4	4	0
(c) Not less than 100 but less than 200 Full Playing Members ..	2	12	6
(d) Not less than 50 but less than 100 Full Playing Members ..	1	11	6
(e) For Clubs comprising less than 50 Full Playing Members ..	1	1	0
(f) For Individual Members ..	0	10	6

Default.

7.—The Membership of any Club or individual whose subscription is in arrear and unpaid for three calendar months may be forthwith determined by the Council.

Accounts.

8.—The financial year of the Association shall close on the 30th September in each year, and an annual Statement of Accounts shall be prepared by the Honorary Treasurer and shall be duly audited as soon as possible thereafter.

Annual General Meeting.

9.—A General Meeting of the Association shall be held annually at such place and time as the Council shall determine during the month of October or November, when the audited accounts for the past year shall be presented, the officers and other Members of the Council, and Auditors for the ensuing year elected and all general business transacted. For this and all other General Meetings, ten shall form a quorum.

Other General Meetings.

10.—An Extraordinary General Meeting of the Association may be called at any time at the discretion of the Council, and shall be called by the Honorary Secretary within three weeks after the receipt by him of a requisition in writing to that effect given by ten or more affiliated Clubs. Such requisition shall be signed by the Honorary Secretary or some other responsible official of each requisitioning Club, and shall state clearly and precisely the object for which such Meeting is to be called. All expenses incurred in the convening and holding of such Meeting shall be borne by the requisitioning Clubs, unless the Council shall otherwise determine. Individual Members of the Association shall not be entitled to requisition a General Meeting under the Rules.

Notice of General Meetings.

11.—Notice in writing of every General Meeting with a brief statement of the business to be transacted shall be sent to (a) every Member of the Council, (b) the Honorary Secretary of every affiliated Club, and (c) every affiliated Member—seven days at least before the date fixed for the holding of such Meeting. In the case of the Annual General Meeting such notice shall be accompanied by a list of the persons nominated as officers, councillors, and auditors for the ensuing year.

Retirement of Officers.

12.—All officers and councillors shall retire annually, but they shall continue to hold office until the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting at which their successors are appointed, and they shall be eligible for re-election.

Districts.

13.—For all administrative, elective, and executive purposes the County shall from time to time be divided into districts or areas by the Council, and the definition of every such area or district with the names of the clubs included therein for the time being shall be published in the Annual Year Book of the Association. Newly-affiliated Clubs shall be allocated to such areas as the Council may determine.

Nominations.

14.—Any affiliated Club or Member may nominate a candidate or candidates for the following offices in the ensuing year, namely:—President, Vice-President, Honorary Treasurer, Honorary Secretary and Auditor, and any affiliated Club may nominate a candidate for the office of Councillor for the district or area in which such Club is situate. All such nominations as aforesaid shall be in writing, and shall be sent to the Honorary Secretary of the Association on or before the 10th day of October in each year. If more than one person is nominated for any office and an election is necessary, such election shall be by ballot. In the absence of nominations for any office the vacancy may be filled up at the Annual General Meeting or may be left to the Council to fill up. No person may occupy two offices, and if so nominated must withdraw from one or the other.

15.—In addition to such right of nomination as aforesaid, the Council for the time being shall have the right to nominate any person or persons for all or any of the offices to be filled up at the Annual General Meeting.

16.—If and whenever there shall be a contest and election at any General Meeting for the office of Councillor for any district or area, the representatives of clubs comprising such district or area shall alone be entitled to vote thereon unless one of the candidates shall have been nominated under Rule 15, in which case all officers and members of such nominating Council shall also be entitled to vote thereon.

Representation at General Meetings.

17.—Save as otherwise provided by Rule 16, all affiliated Clubs (whose subscriptions are not in arrear) shall be entitled to send the following representatives, with power of voting, to every General Meeting, namely:—Clubs paying an annual subscription of £6 6s., five representatives; Clubs paying an annual subscription of £5 5s., four representatives; Clubs paying an annual subscription of £4 4s., three representatives; Clubs paying an annual subscription of £2 12s. 6d., two representatives; and Clubs paying an annual subscription of £1 11s. 6d. or less, one representative. Every officer and other member of the Council shall be entitled to vote at General

Meetings, but affiliated Members of the Association, although entitled to attend, may not vote at such Meetings. Voting by proxy is prohibited, and Clubs may be represented only by *bona-fide* members thereof.

18.—Notice of any proposition, resolution, or special business intended to be brought forward at any Annual General Meeting shall be sent in writing to the Honorary Secretary on or before the 10th day of October preceding such Meeting.

Resignation of Members.

19.—Any affiliated Club or Member wishing to resign membership of the Association must give notice in writing to the Honorary Secretary before the 1st day of October in any year, and in default will be held liable for the subscription for the ensuing year.

County Qualification.

20.—No player shall be eligible to play for the County in Matches or to enter for the County Championships unless—(a) he or she is a Member of the Association or of an affiliated Club, and (b) unless he or she has a birth qualification or has been in continuous residence in Yorkshire for at least two years.

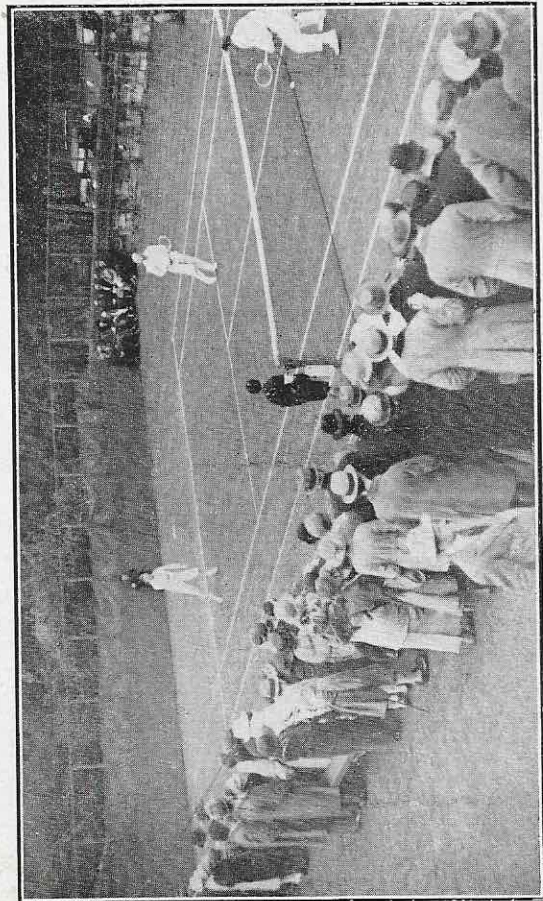
Obligation of Members.

21.—On or before the 1st day of January in each year every affiliated Club shall send to the Honorary Secretary of the Association the full name and address of its Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer for the ensuing season, together with such other information as the Honorary Secretary may reasonably require, and shall also signify its intention of competing or not competing in the Inter-Club Competitions for the ensuing season.

22.—The Council shall have power:—

- (a) To make such alterations of, or addition to, these Rules as special or unforeseen circumstances may render necessary, provided that every such alteration or addition is approved by not less than two-thirds of the persons

- present at the Meeting convened to consider the same.
- (b) To utilise and allocate the funds of the Association in such manner and for such purposes consistent with the objects of the Association as it shall think fit.
 - (c) To discharge all proper executive and administrative functions.
 - (d) To nominate candidates for the Council of the L.T.A.
 - (e) To arrange and manage all County and other representative matches and the County Championships.
 - (f) To arrange and manage Competitions and to make all necessary Rules and Regulations for the conduct thereof.
 - (g) To delegate all or any of its powers to any of its officers or to duly appointed Committees and to co-opt lady and other Members to assist them in their work.
 - (h) To prohibit any act or practice by Clubs or players which in the opinion of the Council is detrimental to the game or the best interests of the Association, and to deal with any offending Club or player either by expulsion, the infliction of penalties or otherwise as it may think proper.
 - (i) To fill casual and other vacancies in the Council.
 - (j) To create new districts or areas in the County or subdivide existing districts, and to elect representatives of such districts to the Council.
 - (k) To adopt County Colours or Badges and to award same to players taking part in three County matches in one season if in their discretion they shall think fit to do so, and to prohibit the purchasing of such colours without a warrant in writing from the Honorary Secretary of the Association.
 - (l) To make such regulations and bye-laws and to do all such other things in the interests of the game and the Association as it may deem expedient.

CHAPEL ALLERTON TOURNAMENT, 1923.

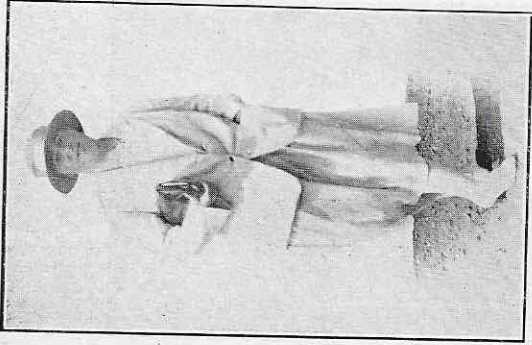
end of the service-line G, may be found by interchanging the measures and repeating the process. The same measurements on the other side of the net will complete the exterior boundaries of the Court. By prolonging the base lines 4ft. 6in. in each direction, and joining the four new points thus obtained, we can make the side-lines of a double Court. It only remains to mark the central line. This is done by joining the middle points of the service-lines. If a double Court alone is required, the interior side-lines need not be prolonged to meet the base-lines; but for obvious reasons nearly all Courts are marked out so as to be available both for singles and doubles play. Remember that in all cases the net posts must stand at a distance of three feet from the side-lines, and therefore that, if a single game is to be played on a double Court, the net (unless the posts are shifted and a single Court net is used) should be stayed up to the right height by means of subsidiary posts placed at a distance of three feet from the single Court side lines. Special posts for this purpose, usually known as "single posts," which can be quickly set up and removed, are obtainable from all makers of lawn tennis implements.



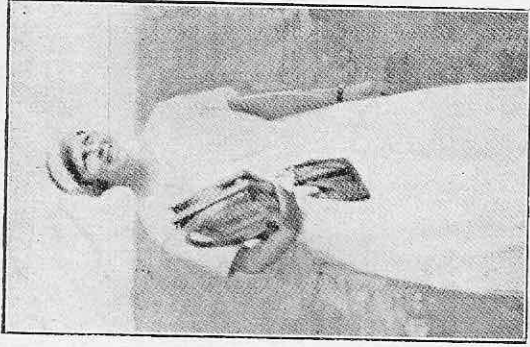
